Handel's great oratorio *Israel in Egypt* was first performed in 1739 and became a favorite of


English audiences. Like Handel's *Messiah* it contains great choruses, fine arias and a strong, compelling story that will make this a performance to remember.

This retelling of the exodus of the Israelites, scored for double chorus and six soloists, will truly be the grand finale to the season.

Featured Artists

Andrea Brock, organist and pianist, has been the Chorale's accompanist for five years. A University of Oregon graduate with a master's degree in Music Education, she also studied Piano Accompaniment in Lyon, France in 1995. She was recently awarded the "Teacher of the Year" designation at South Medford High School and accompanied for vocalists at the Aspen Summer Music Institute in 2002. Mrs. Brock, choral music director at South Medford High School, is married to tenor Andrew Brock. They have a young son, Keenan.

Doug Wisely - After receiving a Bachelor's of Music Education degree from the University of Oregon in 1988, Doug began teaching high school choirs. Beginning in Brookings-Harbor School district, moving to Tillamook and then on to Battle Ground, WA. In 1994 he finished his Masters Degree in Music Education. Since leaving education in 1995, he has performed locally with the Chorale. Currently, Mr. Wisely is senior advisor with Bankers Life and Casualty.
