### DIRECTOR'S NOTES

### A True Icon

I cannot tell you when I was first made aware of Cole



Porter's musicals and his clever songs. Perhaps it was attending my first production of *Anything Goes* or *Kiss Me Kate*; perhaps it was while looking for Broadway songs for my voice students, or perhaps it was for a performance in which I was singing. I cannot tell you the first time I heard a Cole Porter song, but I can tell you that I was smitten from the start by the amazing and tuneful melodies, the jazz-influenced accompaniment, the witty lyrics, and use of dance rhythms that move the song along. Porter composed all types of song equally well, from love ballads to comic songs, from small ensemble numbers to the large, choreographed extravaganzas. In addition, unlike most of his contemporaries of the day, Porter not only composed the music, he was also the lyricist for his songs. I have wanted to pay tribute to this icon of Broadway for a long time!

Today you will hear Broadway favorites, love ballads, comic numbers, and sultry torch songs. We highlight two of Porter's most well-known Broadway musicals, *Kiss Me Kate* and *Anything Goes*. Also highlighted are many of the very talented singers from the Chorale, who will present featured solo numbers, duets, and quartets.

This Cole Porter tribute marks the final concert of the 2018–2019 Season and the third concert for which I have served as the Artistic Director of this remarkable organization known as the Rogue Valley Chorale Association. It has been a pleasure to get to know the many talented singers of the Chorale as we presented the music of Bach, Schubert, Haydn, Brahms, and Randall Thompson. The Chorale soared in the presentation of the world premiere of the commissioned work *Origin of the Song (Cuicapeuhcayotl)* by composer Joseph Julian Gonzalez. The Chorale then shared the music of Maestro Gonzalez in two special outreach performances, one at the Paiute Reservation in Burns, Oregon and again here in Ashland for the Guanajuato, Mexico, sister-city delegation. Both of these performances became amazing cultural exchanges through the power of music and song.

The 2019/2020 season will be one of collaboration. The adult Chorale will join with RVCA's Cantare Chorus in December, the Youth Ensemble for the Mozart *Requiem* in March, and for the final concert in May, the Rogue Valley Chorale and the Jefferson State Choral Coalition will join forces to present the musical magic of composer/arranger Kirby Shaw.

I am honored and grateful to work with such dedicated and talented people. My first season with the Rogue Valley Chorale Association has been exciting, challenging, a bit overwhelming at times, but always enjoyable. Thank you to the Chorale, the RVCA Board of Directors, Executive Director Laura Rich, and you, the patrons, for making my wife, Linda, and me feel at home here in the Rogue Valley!

## ARTISTIC DIRECTOR/CONDUCTOR



Michael Morris is a seasoned voice teacher, conductor, and singer with over 40 years of professional experience. He has served on the music faculty at Holy



Names College in Oakland, CA, Notre Dame de Namur University in Belmont, CA, Ohlone College in Fremont, CA, Santa Clara University, and De Anza College in Cupertino, CA. Michael has been the Music Director and Conductor for such diverse organizations as the Mission Peak Chamber Singers, Lyric Theatre of San Jose, CA, Los Altos Conservatory Theater, Los Altos United Methodist Church, Saint Jude's Episcopal Church in Cupertino, CA, and Saint Simon's Catholic Church in Los Altos, CA.

Michael is also a well-known and respected baritone soloist, having sung the leading roles in some 80 operas, operettas, and musicals with such companies as Opera San Jose, West Bay Opera, and Rogue Valley Opera. He is a frequent soloist for concert work with large orchestras and choral organizations. A voice teacher for over 40 years, Michael is known as a "teacher's teacher" and instructs many professional singers and music teachers in his studio, Michael Morris Studio, LLC, that has run continually since its founding in 1976. He is also an experienced clinician for voice, opera, choral workshops, as well as vocal master classes in repertoire, performance, and audition technique.

Michael received his Master of Music Degree in Vocal Performance from Notre Dame de Namur University and his Bachelor of Music Degree in Music Education from San Francisco State University. He studied opera at the American Institute of Music Studies in Graz, Austria, where he received the George London Award for Vocal Performance.

Michael recently relocated to the Rogue Valley with his wife Linda, who now sings first alto in the Chorale. We are thrilled that Michael shares his exceptional educational, artistic, and directorial skills and experience with the Rogue Valley Chorale and anticipate many years of creating and sharing outstanding choral music in the Rogue Valley — and beyond.

David has played symphonically throughout the Midwest, including onstage at Chicago Lyric Opera, and most notably with the Chicago Chamber Orchestra, which toured East Germany the year before the Wall came down.

Since settling in the Rogue Valley, David has played with Rogue Valley Symphony, as well as with North State, Jefferson Baroque, Opera Brava, Rogue Music Theater, Shakespeare Festival, and the Camelot and Cabaret Theaters. He has also been seen performing with the Ashland City Band, the Southern Oregon Jazz Orchestra, Salsa Brava, and the Thor Polson Jazz Trio.

### ACCOMPANIST MIKIKO S. PETRUCELLI

Mikiko S. Petrucelli was born in Tokyo, Japan where she first started playing piano at the age of 4. She attended the Mushashino Academia Musicae and



received her undergraduate degree in Piano Performance. She then moved to Germany and earned a Performance Degree from the Hochschule für Musik in Detmold, Germany. After she returned to Japan, Mikiko played with the string chamber group Uovo as their guest pianist, touring Japan and giving chamber and solo concerts in Germany. She has played on NHK radio, the national public radio station in Japan, and won a special award at the Josef Dichter Competition in Vienna, Austria in 2001.

In 2004 Mikiko moved to the United States and received a Masters of Music from Baylor University and Doctor of Musical Arts in Piano Performance from the University of Nebraska, Lincoln.

In 2008, as a result of winning the Chiara Competition, Mikiko performed Dvorak's Piano Quintet with the Chiara Quartet. She has also studied Historical Performance Practice in fortepiano. In 2008, she was invited to an international conference, as a result of a complete Hixson-Lied Presentation of Scholarly and Creative Activity Grant. She attended an international conference "The Art of the Fortepiano" and performed in several concerts in Middleburg, the Netherlands.

Mikiko has extensive experience as a chamber and solo pianist as well as an accompanist. She served for three years as an adjunct faculty member at Doane College in Crete, Nebraska. Mikiko joined the Rogue Valley Chorale as accompanist in 2015.



## CONDUCTOR EMERITUS

Lynn Sjolund, Founding Artistic Director/Conductor Emeritus of the Rogue Valley Chorale, served as Artistic Director from 1973 until 2013. During his tenure, the Chorale presented hundreds of concerts to the community, toured Europe seven times, performed at Carnegie Hall and made a lasting impact on the Rogue Valley community. The Rogue Valley Chorale singers will forever hold a place in their hearts for Conductor Emeritus Lynn Sjolund.
