The Rogue Valley Chorale celebrates its 22nd year of exceptional singing with an exciting schedule of three concerts: an inspiring Christmas program, a collection of joyous coronation anthems, and a revue of memorable songs from the American stage.

Chorale singers come from throughout the valley to perform and share some of the finest and most interesting choral music from all periods and genres. The Chorale is widely acclaimed for its wonderful sound, remarkable precision and outstanding soloists.

In 1993 the Chorale made a 20th anniversary trip to Hungary, Austria and the Czech Republic. Throughout the tour, the Chorale made friends and sang to enthusiastic audiences. In Veszprem, Hungary, the Chorale was the featured choir in the city's International Choral

Festival. The Veszprem Festival concluded with an exhilarating performance of Kodaly's *Tu Deum* by the Chorale, a symphony orchestra, the Veszprem city choir and Hungarian choral directors.

Lynn Sjolund directs the Chorale. Mr. Sjolund has conducted groups around the country and is well-known as a guest director and choral adjudicator. The Chorale's founder, he has prepared and conducted such works as Bach's *Mass in B Minor*, Brahms' *Requiem*,

Mozart's *Solemn Vespers and Requiem*, and Bernstein's *Chichester Psalms*. In addition, he has produced and conducted operas for the Rogue Opera, including *La Traviata*, *Tosca*, *Don Pasquale*, and *Barber of Seville*. This is his 19th year as musical director, having been out of the area for three years while teaching at Loyola University of New Orleans. □
