The "Mass in B Minor" represents a significant portion of Bach's career and was the last of his major works.

Ellen Phillips Frohnmayer will be the soprano soloist, and Mira Frohnmayer will perform the contralto arias and duets (Their photographs appear on the cover).

Tenor soloist will be James Stanard, professor of voice at Humboldt

State University in Eureka, Calif. Ellison Glattly of Southern Oregon State College will be the bass/baritone soloist.
