# Chorale announces two fall concerts

The Rogue Valley Chorale, currently in its third season, will present its fall concerts next week.

The 81 member group, which has been in rehearsal since Sept. 23, will perform Sunday, Nov. 23 at 3 p.m., at the Medford Senior High School auditorium, and Monday, Nov. 24 at 8 p.m. at the First Baptist Church, Grants Pass.

Members of the Chorale are from many areas of the Rogue Valley, including Grants Pass, Glendale, Eagle Point, Jacksonville, Ashland, Rogue River, Central Point, Talent, Phoenix, and Medford.

The program will include selections by Vaughn Williams and J. S. Bach, and as a special salute to the bicentennial, works by American composer, Aaron Copland, who celebrated his 75th birthday on Nov. 15, and a group of selections by Stephen Foster.

Lynn Sjolund and accompanied by Phyllis Hunter. Carroll Graber is assistant director. The Rogue Valley Chorale board of directors has recently added new members to its ranks.
