Original song sought by Rogue Valley Chorale

The Rogue Valley Chorale, an 80-voice choral group directed by Lynn E. Sjolund, is offering a prize for an original composition for a

large mixed chorus.

The project is jointly sponsored by a grant from the Oregon Arts Commission and by the National Endowment for the Arts, a federal agency created by an act of Congress, 1965.

Entries, which should not have been performed publicly, should be between 8 and 15 minutes in length. Voicing should be for four or more parts (soprano, alto, tenor and bass), with limited accompaniment.

Since the work will be performed in honor of the Bicentennial, the text should

be of American origin.

The winning composition will be performed in the fall of 1976. Entries should be submitted by March 15.
