

Rogue Valley Chorale sets spring concert

The Rogue Valley Chorale will present its spring concert at 8 p.m. Tuesday, April 20, at the Southern Oregon State College Music Recital Hall. The concert will feature American music, including four numbers by Billings, an 18th century American composer; three songs by Barber, a contemporary American composer; and a collection of spirituals. Also included on the program is Vaughn Williams Mass in G Minor, for double chorus and soloists. The soloists are Kathy Gordon, soprano; Doris Sjolund, alto; Deanne Tack, tenor; and Brian Tingle, bass.

The 65-voice choir is presently in its third season. It presents two concerts annually in the valley. It is under the direction of Lynn Sjolund, with Carroll Graeber acting as assistant director.

Members of the Chorale from Ashland include John and Carolyn Leavens, Libby and Debra McFadden, Patricia Gaddis, Paul Hedges, Alan Gray and Brian Tingle. Tudy Maddox and Elizabeth Muller-Lorish represent Ashland on the Rogue Valley Chorale Board of Directors.

Tickets for the concert are \$1.50 for adults and 75 cents for students. They are available either from Chorale members or at the door.
