

Joint concert to pair chorale, brass choir

The Rogue Valley Chorale and the Southern Oregon State College Brass Choir will present a joint concert at 8 o'clock tonight in the SOSC Music Building Recital Hall.

Lynn Sjolund, choral director at Medford High School, will conduct the Rogue Valley Chorale. The college brass choir is directed by Marvin Belford, chairman of the SOSC Music Department.

The choral group, accompanied by the brass, will present two Gabrieli selections, "Jubilate Deo" and "In Ecclesiis," in addition to "Fanfare for a Festival" by Nelson. The Brass Choir will play four numbers — Gabrieli's "Canzon duodecimi toni" and "Sonato octavi toni," Palestrina's "Laudate dominum in tympanis" and Gallus' "Alleluia."
