ROGUE VALLEY CHORALE is in its ninth year of performance. Seventy singers selected by audition, rehearse on a regular basis for spring and fall programs. The Chorale has appeared with the Rogue Valley Symphony and was invited to perform at the Northwest Music Educators Conference in 1981. During the summer months members of the Chorale make up the Peter Britt Festival chorus. All members of the chorale have considerable vocal experience and many music teachers from the Rogue Valley are regular members.

LYNN SJOLUND has been the music director and conductor of the Rogue Valley Chorale since its organization in 1973. He has earned music degrees from the University of Oregon and has spent a year studying in Germany. Mr. Sjolund is President of the Oregon Music Educators Association, Chairman of the Fine Arts Department of Medford Senior High School and is presently serving on the Governor's Task Force on Arts and Education. As director of the Medford High School Choir, Mr. Sjolund has lead his group's performance on NBC radio, and for many local, state and Pacific Northwest conventions. He has been Chorale director for the Peter Britt Chorale and his groups have made many appearances at the Peter Britt Festival.

ROGUE VALLEY CHILDREN'S CHORUS is performing its premiere concert this evening. The Chorus will be singing a program of folk music. The Children's Chorus has 60 voices and includes boys and girls from 23 different schools in the Rogue Valley. The group practices every week and is planning a concert before school is out. Doris Sjolund is the Director and Judy Cushing is the accompanist.

DORIS SJOLUND graduated from the University of Northern Iowa and the University of Oregon. She has taught vocal and instrumental music at all levels and has served as music coordinator for District 9 Schools. She is currently teaching elementary music at Hoover School in Medford and serves as secretary-treasurer of the Oregon Music Educators Association.

HOLLY THEATRE is the site of the Medford performance of the Rogue Valley Chorale. The theater was once used regularly by travelling companies and has retained much of its accoustical excellence. The Theater was built in 1930 and introduced movies as well as providing an opportunity for local talent to perform plays and musicals. The theater retains the capability to do these types of performance even though today it primarily used as a movie theatre.
