LYNN SJOLUND

Lynn Sjolund has been the musical director and conductor of the Rogue Valley Chorale since its organization in 1973. He has received music degrees from the University of Oregon and has spent a year studying in Germany. Mr. Sjolund is a past president of the Oregon Music Educators Association, and the Jackson County Community Concert Association. He is well-known throughout the northwest as a clinician and adjudicator. As director of the Medford Senior High School Choir, Mr. Sjolund has led his groups to performances on NBC Radio and for many local, state and northwest area conventions.

LARRY CRUMMER

Larry Crummer is an Assistant Professor of Music at Southern Oregon State College where he teaches organ, theory, and music history. He received his Bachelor of Music Degree from Morningside College, Sioux City Iowa, in 1971. Mr. Crummer also has a Master of Music in Organ from Indiana University, Bloomington, where, in 1973 he was awarded a Performer's Certificate for outstanding performance. Mr. Crummer is currently working on a doctorate in organ performance and literature at Indiana University, where he studies with Dr. Oswald G. Ragatz, internationally known teacher and performer. Having played many recitals throughout the Midwest, Mr. Crummer is now preparing for a tour of Washington, Oregon, and California this coming winter.

GLENN MATTHEWS

Dr. Glenn Matthews has been an instructor at Southern Oregon State College since 1946. He received his doctoral degree from the University of Oregon and is currently teaching woodwinds and composition. Dr. Matthews has performed many recitals on both the oboe and the English horn, and is a published composer as well. "Citation", a concert march, is one of his most recently published works. In addition to teaching, performances and composition, Dr. Matthews is now serving as president of the Southern Oregon Arts Council.
