



# FROM THE DIRECTOR

The Rogue Valley Chorale Association performed its first Festival of Choirs in 2015 in which all five of its choruses took



the stage together for the first time in the organization's 42-year history. Based upon the success of that event, we have decided to make a tradition of performing a joint concert every two years. We think this is a wonderful way for our chorus members as well as audience members to witness the mission of our organization, which is to inspire and enrich our communities through great choral music performed by singers of all ages.

The pure voices of Discovery Chorus, the Chorale Association's youngest participants (grades 3-4) open our presentation of ascending skill levels, youngest to oldest. As the concert continues, Children's Chorus (grades 5-6) demonstrates greater mastery of vocal control and harmonization. Cantare Chorus (grades 7-9) presents an ever-increasing expression of musical complexity as deepening male voices are incorporated into the harmonies. Youth Ensemble, RVCA's high school chorus, demonstrates a passage into maturing vocal ability during a performance of challenging choral literature.

This year we are giving the high school singers of the Rogue Valley Youth Ensemble an opportunity to sing with an orchestra alongside the adult singers of the Chorale. To that end, we have also initiated a program in which Chorale members mentor some of the youth singers. I chose Mozart's Missa Brevis (short mass) in C major, K. 220, because it gives the flavor and complexity of some of Mozart's longer works, but is only 20 minutes in duration. Mozart composed the mass in 1775 at the age of nineteen. It contains all the usual movements associated with longer masses, and utilizes a quartet of soloists in four of the six movements. It was given the nickname "Sparrow" Mass because of a repeated grace note figure in the accompaniment of the "Hosanna" section of the Sanctus and Benedictus that is said to resemble the chirping of birds.

The concert concludes with all five choruses taking the stage together in a poignant performance of *Inscription of Hope*. The song's text is based on fragments of a poem found on a cellar wall in Cologne, Germany, where Jews were hiding from the Nazis during World War II: "I believe in the sun, even when it is not shining. I believe in love, even when there is no one there. I believe in God, even when He is silent. I believe through any trial, there is always a way." We hope these words will inspire you and our concert will bring you joy in whatever trials you may be facing on your own journey.

# ARTISTIC DIRECTOR I AURIE HUNTER

CHRISTOPHER BRISCOE

A native of Pasadena, California, Laurie Anne Hunter received her B.A. from the University of Winnipeg and her Masters in Piano Accompanying from the

Juilliard School in New York. She spent five seasons as an Assistant Conductor and Vocal Coach with the New York City Opera, becoming only the fourth woman ever to conduct there when she made her Lincoln Center debut with Marc Blitzstein's Regina in 1992. Guest conducting appearances followed with the New England Lyric Operetta, Skylight Opera Theatre in Milwaukee, and the Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony.

She was Associate Conductor of *Phantom of the Opera* in Toronto and *Showboat* on Broadway, and Assistant Conductor and Vocal Coach for the Opera Theatre of Saint Louis, Augusta Opera, Mobile Opera, Boston Concert Opera, and the Metropolitan Opera Guild's educational productions. She headed the music staff for two years at the Banff Centre's Music Theater program in Canada, and worked with American Musical Theater of San Jose and the Seattle Opera. Ms. Hunter has been on the faculty of the Hartt School of Music in Hartford, Connecticut, the Israel Vocal Arts Institute in Tel Aviv, and the Musicians Club of America summer Opera and Lieder Institutes in North Carolina.

In 2001, the Oregon Shakespeare Festival brought her to Ashland as Musical Director and Pianist for *Enter the Guardsman*, and she has been an active and valuable part of the Rogue Valley's musical scene ever since. She has been an adjunct faculty member at Southern Oregon University since 2001, and music director at the First Presbyterian Church in Ashland since 2010. Additional contributions to the musical life of the Rogue Valley include work with the Oregon Cabaret Theatre, Southern Oregon University Theatre Productions, Southern Oregon Repertory Singers, Rogue Valley Symphony, Rogue Opera, and the Brava! Opera Theatre/James M. Collier Young Artist program. She took up the harp while earning her certification from the "Music for Healing and Transition Program" and for many years played therapeutic harp music for Providence Cancer Center and Hospice in Medford.

Ms. Hunter has been a part of the Rogue Valley Chorale community since 2002, serving as guest accompanist, Board member, and guest conductor before being appointed as the Chorale's Artistic Director and Conductor in 2013. She is delighted to have become more closely acquainted with this fine group of singers and to have gained so many new friends.

#### WENDY CAWTHORNE (Discovery Chorus)

Wendy Cawthorne was born and raised in Central Point, Oregon. She has been an elementary school educator since 2002 and is currently the sole elementary music teacher in the Central Point school district. Wendy holds a BA in music and a Master of Arts in Teaching, both from Southern Oregon University. She resides in Central Point with her husband, 3 children, and 3 step-children.



#### GERRY FLOCK (Children's Chorus)

Gerry Flock taught music in local schools for 21 years. He is currently the principal at Wilson Elementary School. Mr. Flock served as Director of the Rogue Valley Discovery/Children's Chorus for seventeen years. He sings with the Rogue Valley Chorale, and serves as an elder in his church. Gerry and his wife, September Flock, have three sons, all of whom are involved with music.



#### SHAUN GARNER (Cantare Chorus)

Shaun Garner previously lived in northwest Montana, where she was the founding director of the Glacier Children's Choir and the Glacier Symphony Chorale. Shaun has directed chamber groups, community choirs, school choirs and church choirs, and is an accomplished organist, pianist, and harpist. She is an avid gardener and crafter, and enjoys the rich cultural diversity of Southern Oregon.

Pamela Nordquist received a master's degree in choral conducting at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. Pamela has taught elementary, middle and high school music and chorus and currently co-directs the choirs at South Medford High School. She is an active guest clinician/conductor for middle school and high school choirs, and is currently serving as President of the American Choral Director's Association of Oregon. Pamela founded the Rogue Valley Youth Ensemble in 2002.

He was a featured soloist during GFU's centennial celebration in 1992—performing Khachaturian's Piano Concerto. Jim has taught K-12 music since



1988 and has served as accompanist for the Rogue Valley Youth Choruses for the past 18 years. Upon earning his Master's Degree in Education from SOU in 2004, he has mainly focused on teaching 5th & 6th grade. He currently teaches 6th grade at Abraham Lincoln Elementary School, accompanies the Rogue Valley Children's Chorus and Cantare Chorus, and serves as a Rogue Valley Chorale Association board member.


