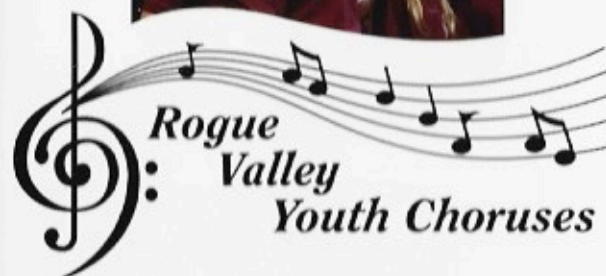




Our Mission

Children's Chorus · grades 5-6

Youth Ensemble · grades 10-12



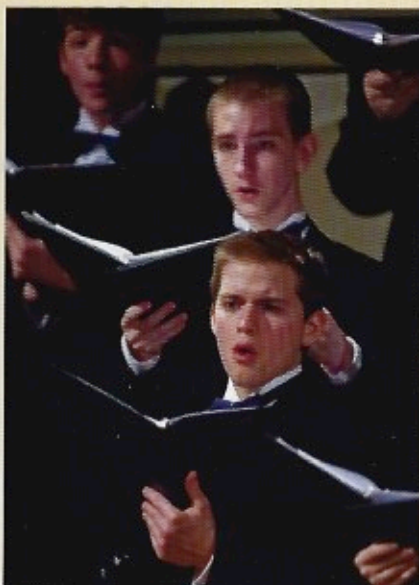
Repertoire is age appropriate and is selected to accommodate each choir's skill level. Choral literature includes classical, folk, spirituals, jazz and contemporary arrangements that provide singers with access to a wide variety of musical styles. RYVC participants receive training in vocal development and musicianship from a team of outstanding directors.

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Benefits of Choral Singing



- ♪ Choral singing lowers heart rate, decreases blood pressure, reduces stress and increases cognitive function.
- ♪ Choral singers exhibit improved social skills and have better memories when compared with non-singers.
- ♪ Children who sing do better across the curriculum and get significantly higher grades than those who have never sung in a choir.
- ♪ Choral singing is an accessible entry point for arts exposure, with fewer barriers—economic, cultural, and educational—than posed by other art forms
- ♪ Music improves the development of language and reasoning skills.
- ♪ Student who are involved in choruses are far more likely to graduate high school and attend college.
- ♪ Students who are in a chorus score higher on the SAT; 63 points on the verbal portion and 44 points higher on the math portion on average.
- ♪ Children with a background in the arts learn to think both creatively and analytically—essential components of innovation.
